In addition to single family dwellings, projects included for this residential survey include the following: Apartment Buildings (four stories or less); private or public College Dorms (four stories or less); Nursing/Assisted Living Facilities (four stories or less); and Residential Subdivisions. Additionally, all related site and infrastructure work for these types of projects will be included in the survey, i.e. Excavation, Storm Sewer, Sanitary Sewers, Waterline, Streets, Parking Lots, Curbs, Sidewalks, etc. Any other incidental or peripheral work performed by your company on any of the above projects should also be included in this residential wage and fringe benefit survey.
